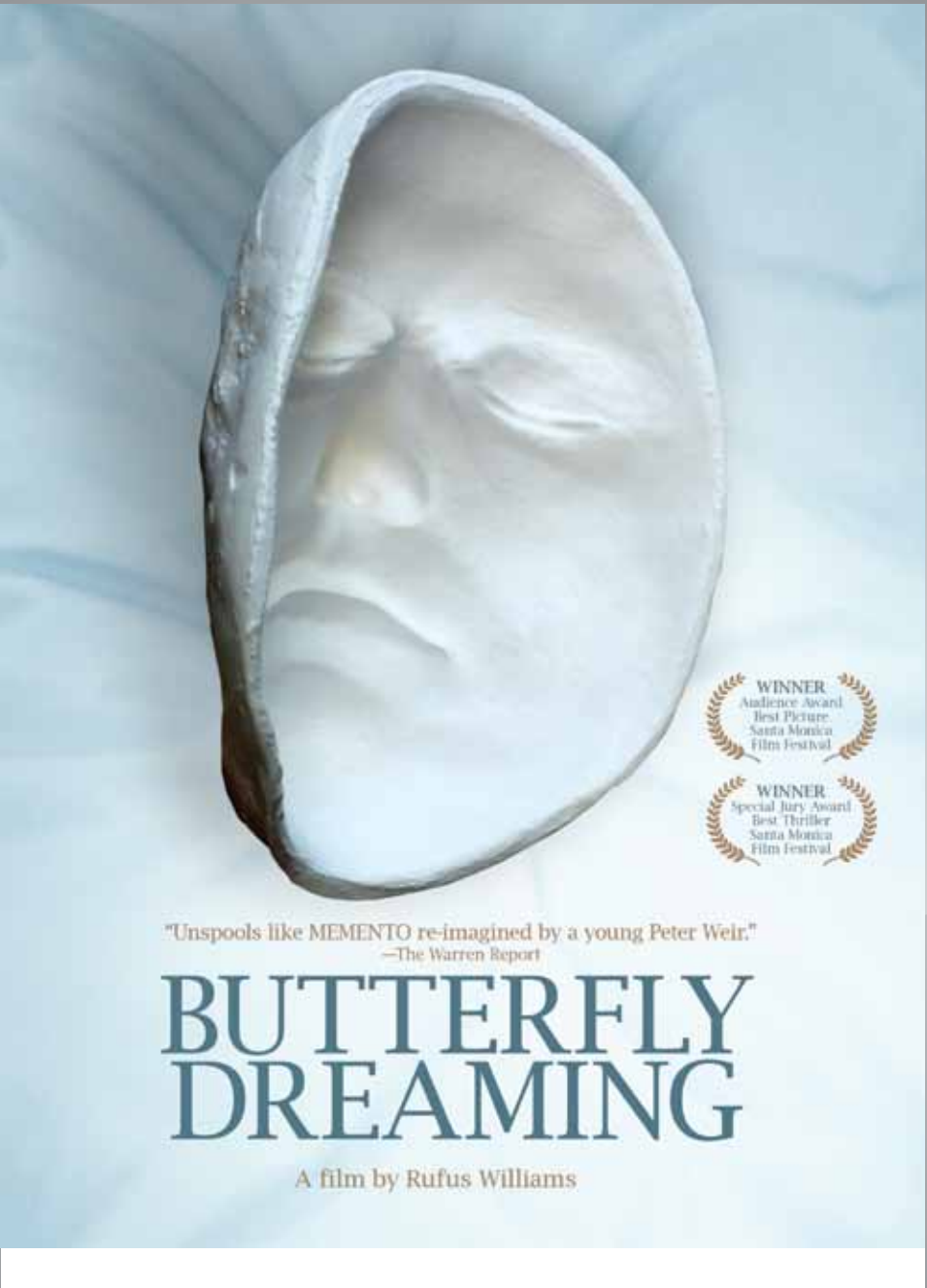




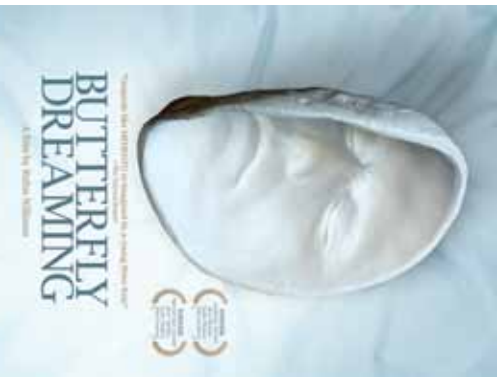

An Aspiring Journalist Comes Of Age Midst A Struggle Between Apathy And Idealism In Today's Youth Culture

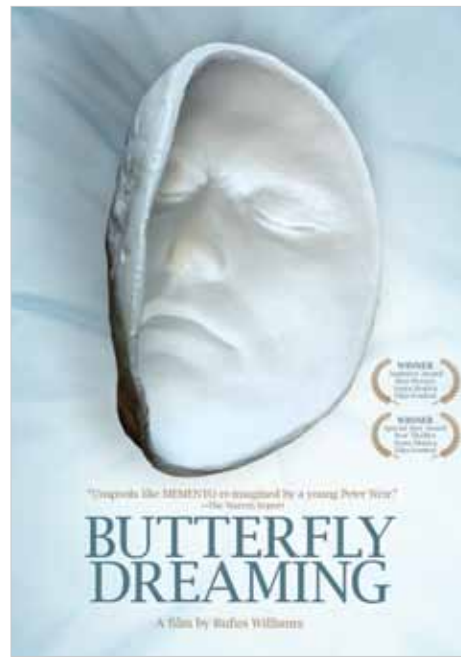

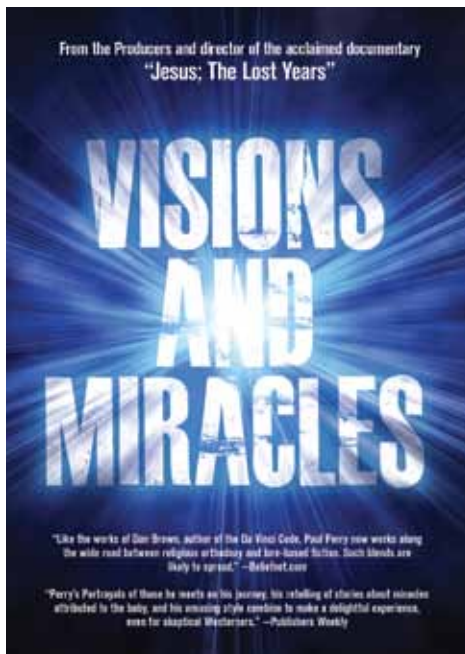

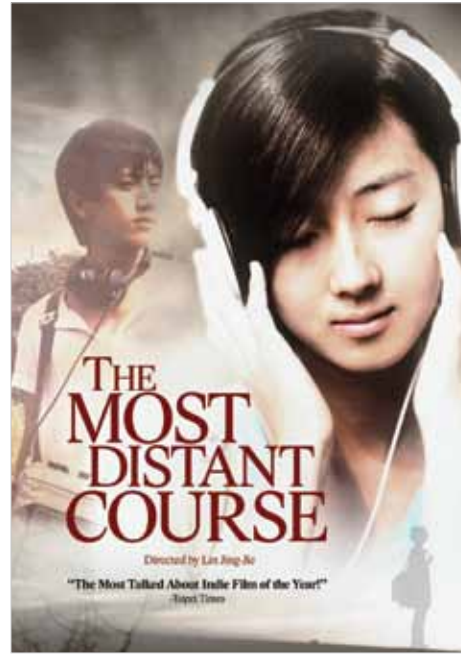
